Pairing: Chehalem, Chardonnay Inox Estate Grown Willamette

#### 3rd Course

Dauphinoise Potatoes with crispy bacon

Pairing: Stoller Estate, Pinot Noir Dundee Hills

#### 4th Course

Short Rib Ravioli with a mushroom demi glaze

Pairing: Chehalem, Pinot Noir Estate Grown Chehalem Mountains

Bread Pudding with a bourbon sauce
